TWO-STAGE CUTTING CHAMBER

The Loftness-exclusive two-stage cutting chamber is capable of processing material more thoroughly than competitive units, since it has two shear bars. Material is initially cut by the primary shear bar, located on the rear bumper. Then, a secondary shear bar behind the front bumper drives material back down into the knives for further processing before it is discharged to the ground.

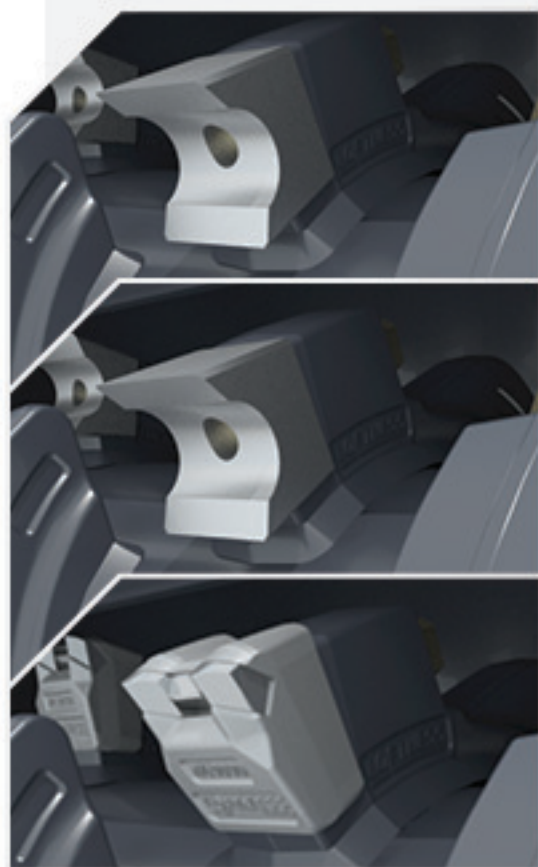

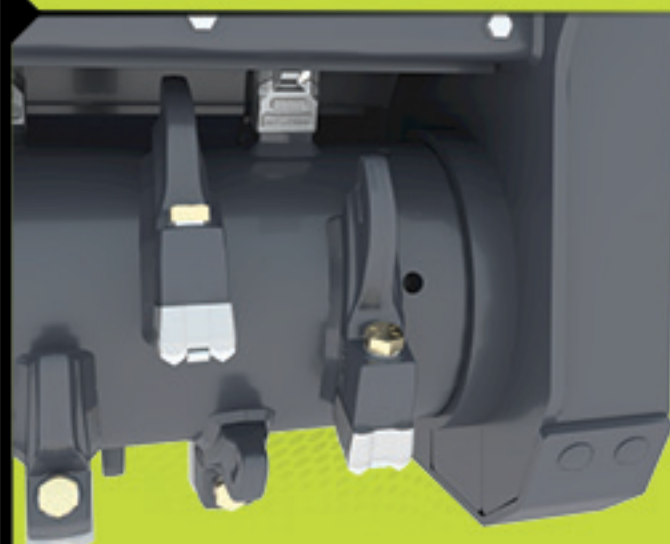
